Directions for Use

Preclean the surface by wiping with a towelette to remove organic soil. Dispose of towelette. To disinfect the precleaned surface, apply **tb Minuteman** liberally by wiping the surface with a towelette until the surface is thoroughly wet. Ensure the surface remains wet for at least 1 minute at room temperature. Then wipe the

Once opened, the unused portion of the product may be stored tightly in the tub container for up to 60 days.
